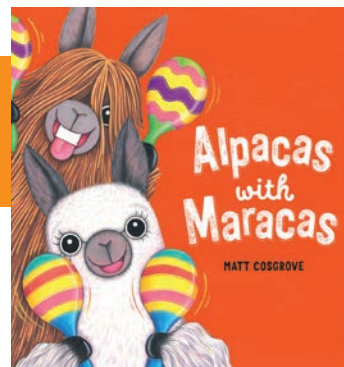

Congratulations to the 160 participants in the 2018/19 Curious Creatures Summer Reading Club (SRC) Challenge.

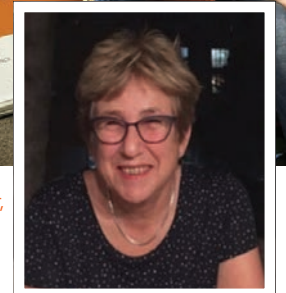

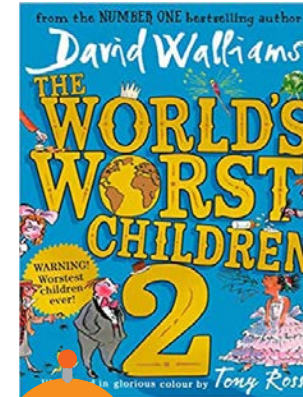


Title: The Junkyard Dragon by Beth Webb

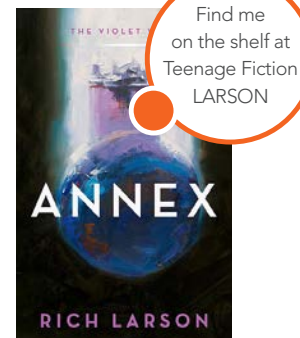
Title: The World's Worst Children 2 by David Walliams

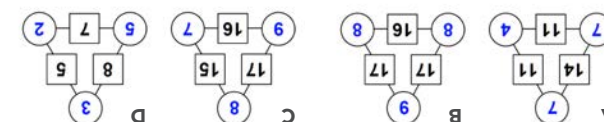
GET PUZZLED

Try and work out which numbers go in the empty circles. The numbers in the square boxes are made by adding together the numbers in the circles on either side.

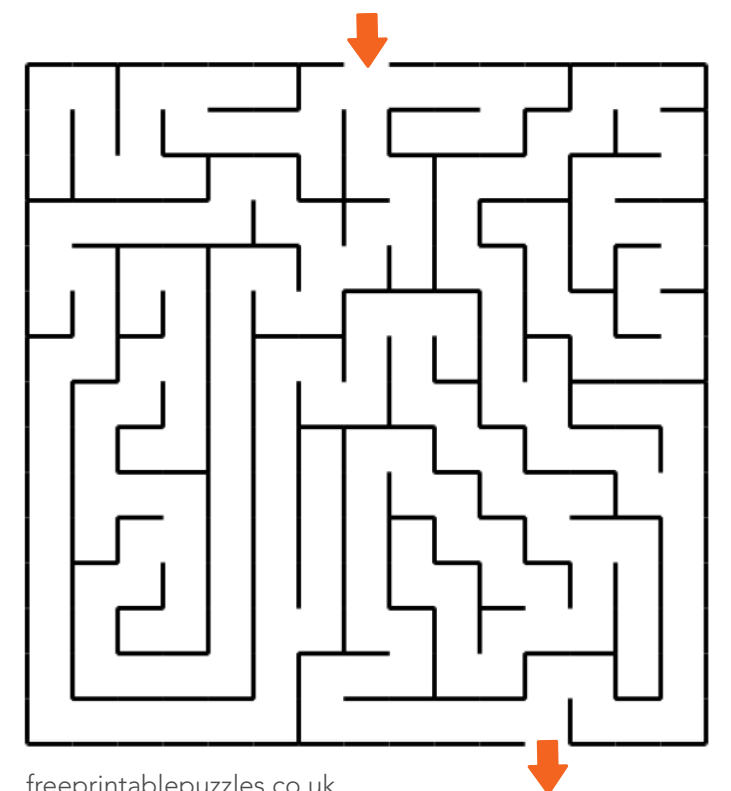

YOU BEAUTY! STORIES OF AUSSIE SPORTING LEGENDS

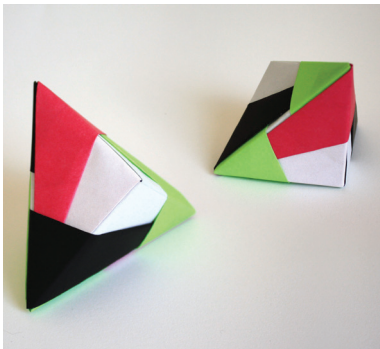
with Charlie Truscott

This workshop is for high school students. We are making some 3D shapes by connecting origami units without glue or scissors. Challenge your mind!

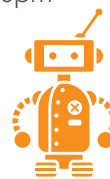

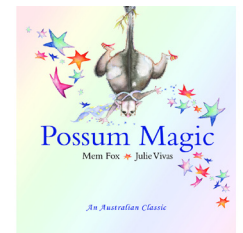
